THE DNA PROFILES DEVELOPED FROM ITEMS #20A-20F, 21A-21D AND 22A MATCHED EACH OTHER.

THE DNA PROFILES DEVELOPED FROM ITEMS #23A AND 23C MATCHED EACH OTHER.

THE DNA PROFILE FROM ITEM #23B REVEALED THE PRESENCE OF A MIXTURE. THE MAJOR COMPONENT OF THE DNA PROFILE FROM ITEM #23B MATCHED THE DNA PROFILES DEVELOPED FROM ITEMS #20A-20F, 21A-21D AND 22A. THE MINOR COMPONENT OF THE DNA PROFILE FROM ITEM #23B WAS CONSISTENT WITH THE DNA PROFILES FROM ITEMS #23A AND 23C.

AN INTERPRETABLE DNA PROFILE COULD NOT BE OBTAINED FROM ITEM #22B.

INTERPRETATION OF THE DNA RESULTS WILL BE PERFORMED WHEN AN EDTA BLOOD CONTROL AND SALIVA SWABS FROM THE SUSPECTS ARE SUBMITTED TO THE CBI LABORATORY.

THE ITEMS SUBMITTED FOR DNA ANALYSIS AND THE EXTRACTED DNA WILL BE PRESERVED FROZEN AT THE CBI LABORATORY FOR TWO YEARS FROM THE ORIGINAL SUBMITTAL DATE.

The DNA profile from item # 23B revealed the presence of a mixture. The major component of the DNA profile from item #23B matched the DNA profiles developed from items #20A-20F, 21A-21B & 22A. The minor component of the DNA profile from item #23B was consistent with the DNA profiles from items #23A & 23C.

An interpretable DNA profile could not be obtained from item # 22B

Interpretation of the DNA results will be performed when an EDTA blood control and saliva swabs from the suspects are submitted to the CBI laboratory.
